OUR INITIATIVES

Srotoshwini is a Vadodara city based Trust, registered in 2010, primarily aimed at working towards the development of underprivileged children and women. The Trust is 12AA, 80C and FCRA compliant. There are 3 main initiatives that run under the Trust:

Pathshala Hostel: a residential facility for children where the focus is, all round development of the child including academics, sports and extra curricular activities, vocational training & career counseling. Pathshala classes now run on hostel campus.

Pathbhavan - A Learning and Development Center that runs in the after-school hours and focuses on nurturing the children of Sanjay Nagar Slum area (Vadodara) through academics and extra curricular activities for all round development.

Churni: a creative initiative that vocationally trains the mothers of our children to empower them by providing a steady income by selling the products they make. We have two centers, one in Sama, Vadodara and another in Lasundra, Savli.

ladies worked on orders independently from home. Pathshala Hostel located in Lasundra, Savli continued to operate since it's a residential hostel for underprivileged children. As they say, every dark cloud comes with a silver lining, it was the true emergence of the Student Council for us. While we've had a student body for a while, the situation really forced them to take matters into their own hands.

They took responsibility of every aspect of keeping the hostel operational and shouldered the responsibilities of the hostel with the 6 hostel mothers. All that we taught was put to the test & they emerged with flying colours. What we learnt was, we can achieve anything with our committed staff and children.

ACADEMICS

Academic Classes

All Pathshala Hostel children go to Navprerna School, an initiative of the Navrachana Education Trust for their formal schooling. Due to the pandemic, it has been closed from March 2020 to today. Academic classes are being held by grade at the hostel premises by local Lasundra village teachers in non-lockdown periods. Exam papers being sent by Navprerna teachers are being used to test the children.

Remote Learning

Due to the length of school closure, we have setup an online class on campus with 6 workstations where children can access online content and specially the senior children can continue to take available classes. We also host Computer classes and online learning content by grade so that online learning can aid the Pathshala classes.

Class X

5 of our children - Ajay, Jyoti, Rani, Poonam and Sejal cleared their X exams in 2020. Mamta cleared her X in 2021 with 74%.

Diploma

Ajay, our eldest child who has been with us from 2013 joined a Diploma course in Mechanical Engineering, KJIT, Savli. He will also continue his XI and XII standard studies.

Skill Development Center

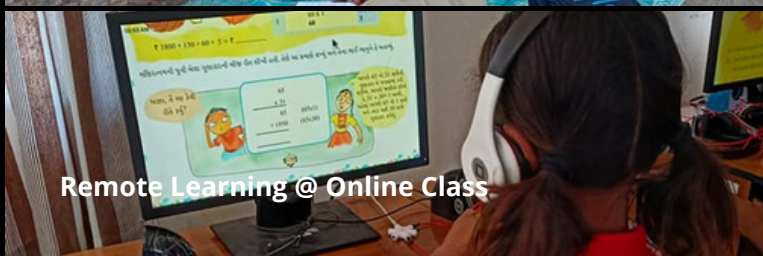

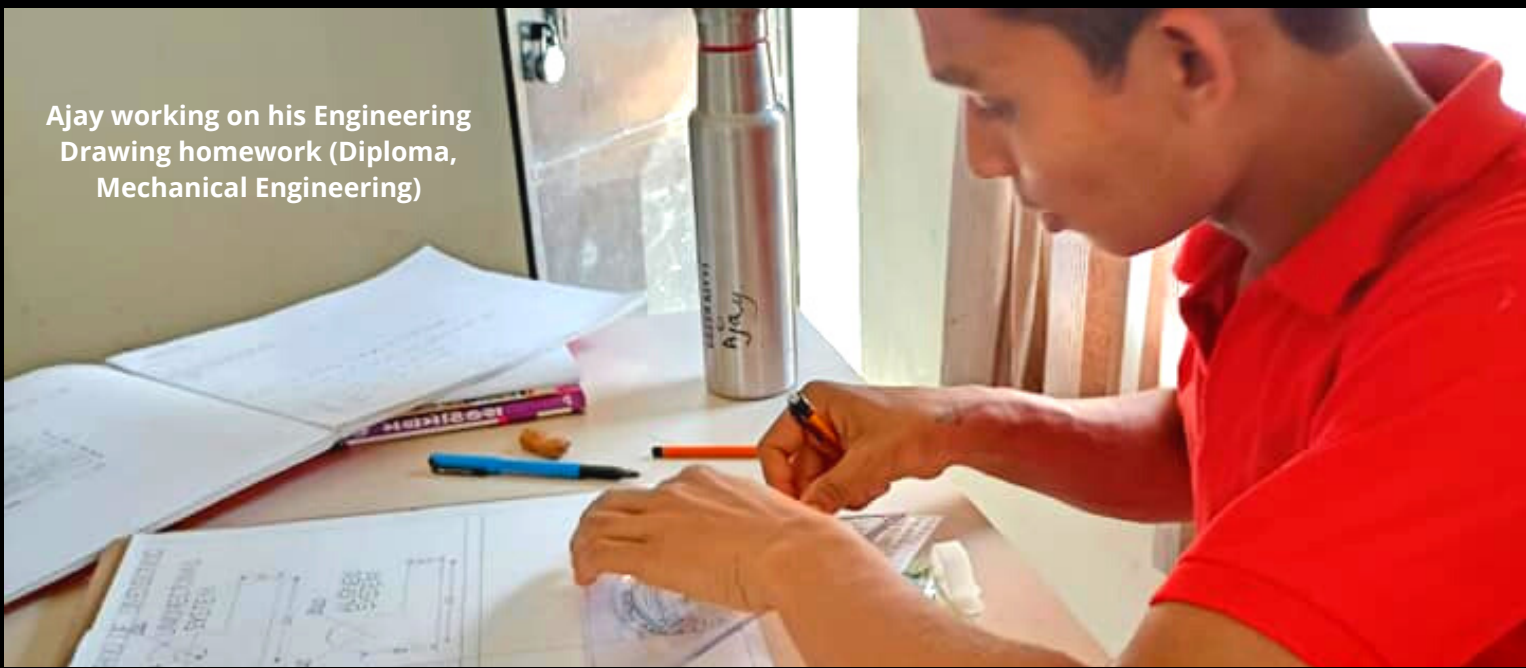

CAREER COUNSELING - UDAAN

We're launching a brand new initiative called Udaan, our career counseling program for Pathshala Hostel and Pathbhavan children. The objectives of this program are:

- Make career counseling a part of the curriculum for standards VIII to XII children.
- Identify potential career options by psychometric assessment and 1-on-1 counseling sessions and preparation of a custom career plan for each child.
- Prepare for the required qualification exams much before they finish their higher secondary studies.
- Project goal is for children to succeed in the exams and get admission in chosen fields with a clear career path to follow.
- Ultimate goal is to stop the cycle of poverty, illiteracy and/or abuse with this generation of children and set them up on the path of success for the future.
- We have identified 27 children from Pathshala and Pathbhavan who will join the first phase of this project.
- Counseling sessions will start on June 14

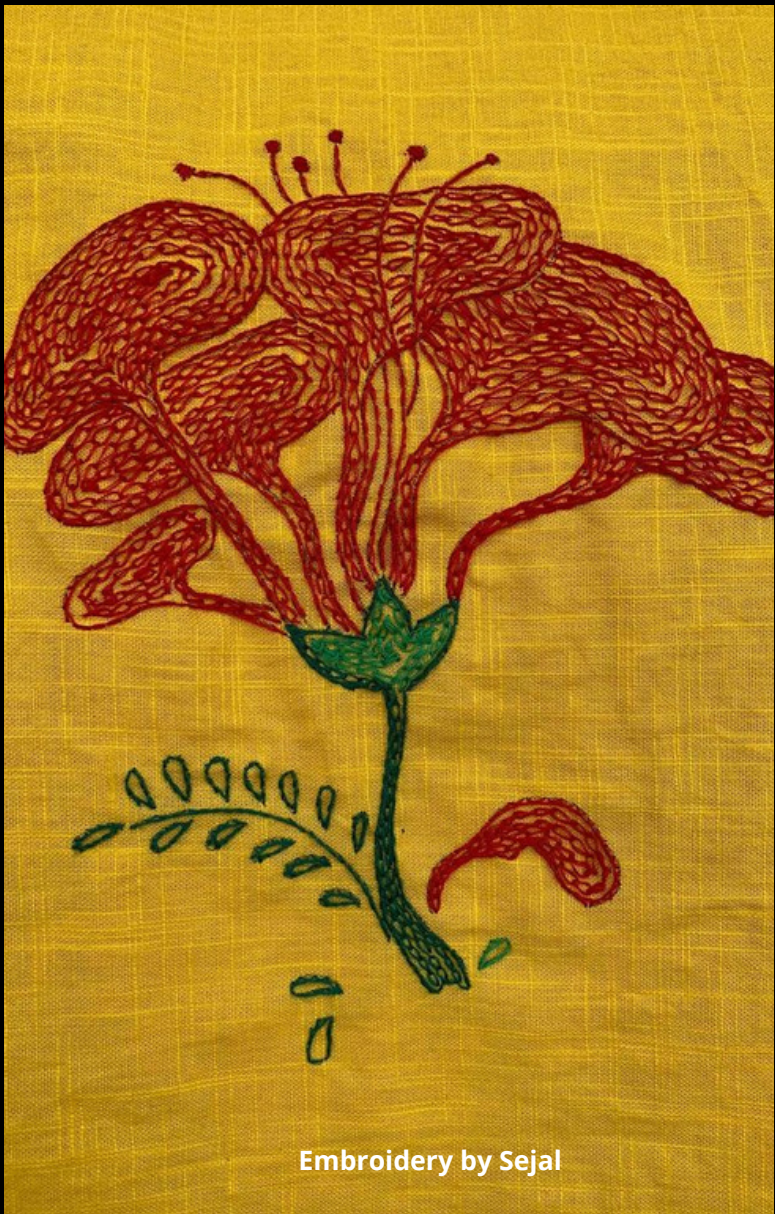

GREEN INITIATIVES

Solar Cooker: Our vision when we built the hostel was to be as environment friendly as possible. This year we made some good strides - we moved all our cooking to the Solar Cooker. We thank Dr. Vikram Patel, President, Muni Seva Ashram and Mr. Deepak Gadhia for the idea/financial support/installation & training.

Organic Farming: We have initiated an organic farming program where we are growing seasonal vegetables and also teaching our children to tend to the plants. This initiative is being lead by Mithu Madam.

No Plastic: We've initiated a major effort to get rid of all plastic furniture and accessories from the campus. We've also undertaken a big effort to get all our grocery items in cloth bags, steel containers and getting delivery from factories like biscuits without the use of plastic packaging and also made our own washing powder in-house.

Rainwater Harvesting: Another initiative to be operational before the monsoons in June, 2021 so that more water can be saved and reused.

ACADEMICS

Academic Classes

Due to the ongoing pandemic, we had to follow the VMC rules for educational institutions and close our primary location. We continued our learning the best we could ...

Junior students:

First half of the year was managed by 1-1 online remote learning with our volunteer mentors. The second half of the year was managed by our senior students teaching English and Hindi words and Maths tables in a common area within the Sanjay Nagar slum.

Class 8-10:

Systematic remote online classes were held for Gujarati, English, Science and Math by Shruti Madam, Sushmita Madam and Mousumi Madam.

Class 10:

Our Class 10 students were also enrolled into Bhavani Tuition classes and attended online classes to prepare for their exams.

Class X

2 of our children - Arvind and Rohit cleared their class X in 2020. Arvind scored 71% in the SSC exams.

Class XII

Ankita Sharma, Sakshi Agrawal and Simran Chauhan passed standard 12th from Nevprerna School. They are the students from our initial years when we started Pathbhavan inside Sanjay Nagar in 2013. Two of them are working in stationary shops and one in a call center.

Diploma

Arvind started Diploma (Electrical Engineering) course in MSU. He'll simultaneously be completing his XII course under NIOS from Nevprerna school. Rohit joined Dashrath ITI college in Motor Mechanic stream. Karishma got admission in Methodist Technical Institute, Vadodara for 2 years in the ITI course. She has successfully completed her first year and will graduate with her Diploma in 2021.

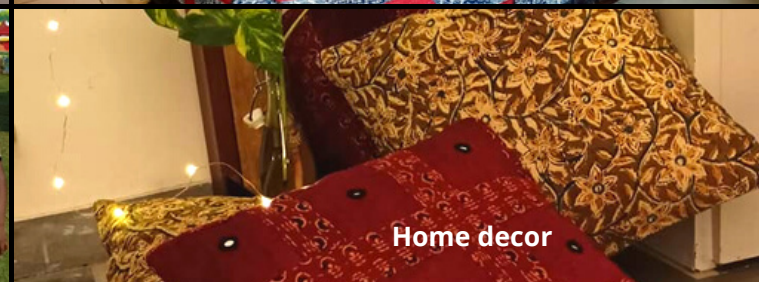

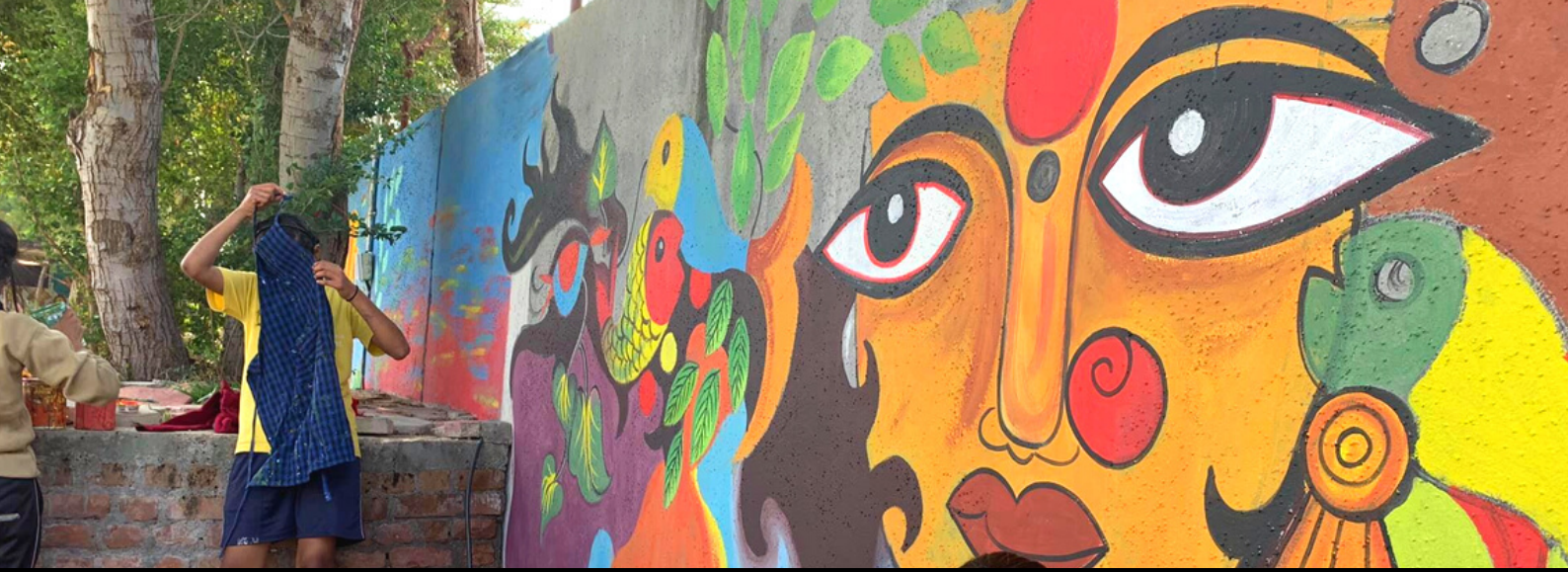
