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OUR INITIATIVES

Srotoshwini is a Vadodara city based Trust, registered in 2010, primarily aimed at working towards the development of underprivileged children and women. The Trust is 12AA, 80G and FCRA compliant. There are 3 main initiatives that run under the Trust:

Pathshala

- **Pathshala Informal School:** a school that has a hybrid learning program that marries the guidelines of Reggio Emilia Philosophy of child-centric education (Project Based Learning) with NIOS board learning expectations so the end result is a very skilled individual ready for joining the workforce.
- **Pathshala Hostel:** a residential facility for children where the focus is, all round development of the child including academics, sports, extra curricular activities, vocational training & career counseling. Pathshala classes now run on hostel campus.

Pathbhavan – A Learning and Development Center that runs in the after-school hours and focuses on nurturing the children of Sanjay Nagar Slum area (Vadodara) through academics and extra curricular activities for all round development.

Churni: a creative initiative that vocationally trains the mothers of our children to empower them by providing a steady income by selling the products they make. We have two centers, one in Gotri, Vadodara and another in Lasundra, Savli.



MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT

The experiences of the last two years, setup year 2023 for us. 2022 was a year of taking action on the lessons learnt from the previous years.

The situation forced us to entirely re-think our formal schooling approach. In late 2021 we decided to adopt Project Based Learning. Our children showed great progress in the first couple of projects through participation and enthusiastically adopting this inquiry based self-reliant form of learning (vs. being spoon fed).

Seeing their progress, we decided to commit to the infrastructure and logistics needed to give them the best environment possible. We finished our classroom construction project in record time, approximately 6 months, thanks to all our corporate, personal donors & Lala bhai and his team of construction workers.

We also shifted into high gear training our staff to first unlearn and then re-learn this new hands-on approach to education. We've consciously engaged the best educators in the city to hold

workshops for our teachers to reinvigorate them with fresh ideas and teaching methods.

Pathbhavan completed an extension construction project of the space at the current location due to a generous donation by a well wisher in 2022. Now we have enough space for classes, activities and performances for 50 children at the Center.

Other than infrastructure improvements, we also went back to regular academic evening classes for all our children. There is a lot of focus on our children's language skill development. They are learning reading, writing and spoken English. Their public speaking skills are being improved by regularly hosting presentations on different topics like festivals & international "day" celebrations.

2022 was the year we planted the seeds. We look forward to the blooms in 2023 & the years to follow...

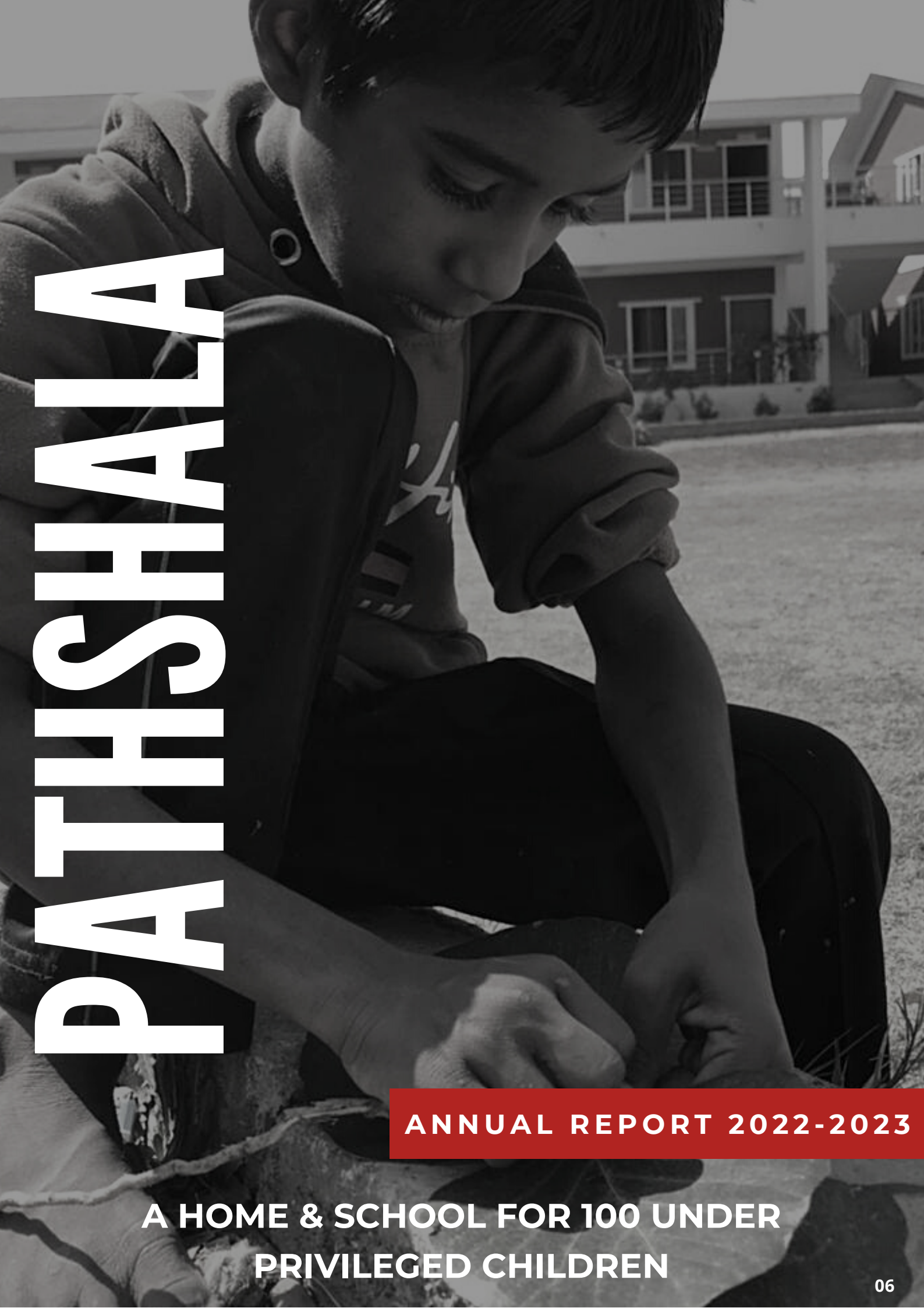

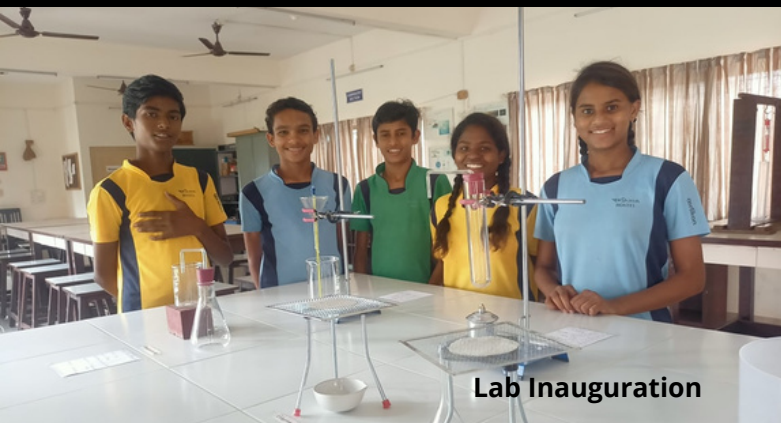

ACADEMICS

School Campus

With the success of the Project Based Learning program under Ms. Paras Mahendru in the last quarter of 2021, we decided to commit to the required infrastructure to support our children's education. Funds were raised for academic classes on campus and construction was completed in a record 6 months. All our children attend classes in classrooms in our Lasundra campus. The children start with 5 levels of learning and then transition to Grade 8 of the NIOS board. They then take the Class 10 and Class 12 exams and transition to diplomas, jobs and/or vocational skill development programs.

Class X & XII

While our plan is to continue with PBL at all the levels, the children will appear for Class X and XII exams held by the NIOS board. This year 10 of children are appearing for class XII, class X & Diploma exams.

Job update:

Ajay, our eldest child who has been with us from 2013 has one semester left. He started a job at Singhal Sheets and Foil Pvt. Ltd.

Nanhi who has also been with us from the beginning has joined a nursing training program @ Muni Seva Ashram, Goraj

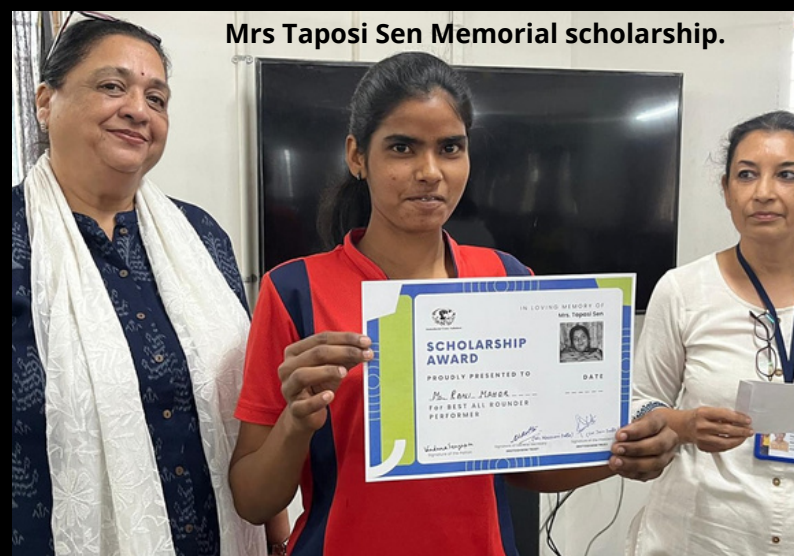

PATHSHALA INFORMAL SCHOOL

Pathshala Classroom construction project was initiated in November 2021. Classrooms were inaugurated in May 2022 for the new 2022-2023 academic session. Construction was completed in 6 months, thanks to our construction team under the leadership of Lalabhai. A big thank you to our corporate and personal donors because of whom we could get this projected completed so quickly. All our Pathshala Hostel children now attend school on campus in Lasundra. Our teaching methodology follows PBL for first five learning levels and then transitions to NIOS board from class 8. We don't follow an age based class/grade system but are more in line with a proficiency based system that promotes children based on their abilities.





GAAM PATHSHALA

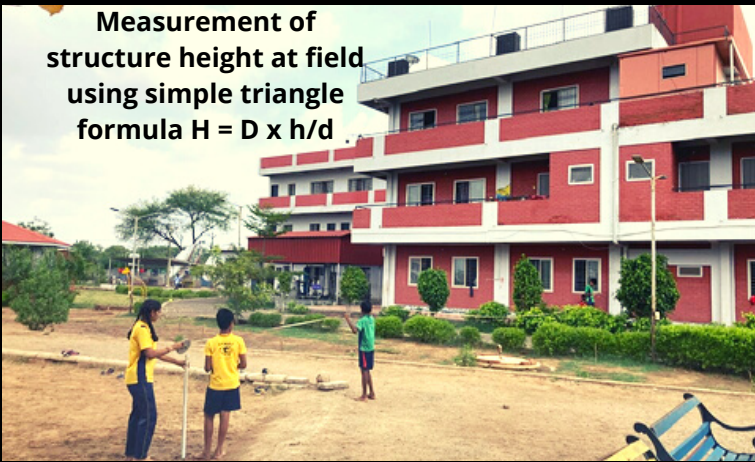
Gaam Pathshala is a Community Outreach program where we plan to share our experiences, learnings and opportunities with the children of our local community. The goal is to bring the village children to mainstream education and eventually the workplace. It's also an opportunity for our Pathshala children to give back whatever they are getting here at Pathshala. This initiative was started on July 11, 2022 and is being led by our Hostel Mother, Mubina with a group of senior children - Radha, Tejal, Manisha L, Manisha S, Sanaulla, Sofiya. Classes are held once a week in Lasundra village. The cycle of giving continues and we wish our team the very best.



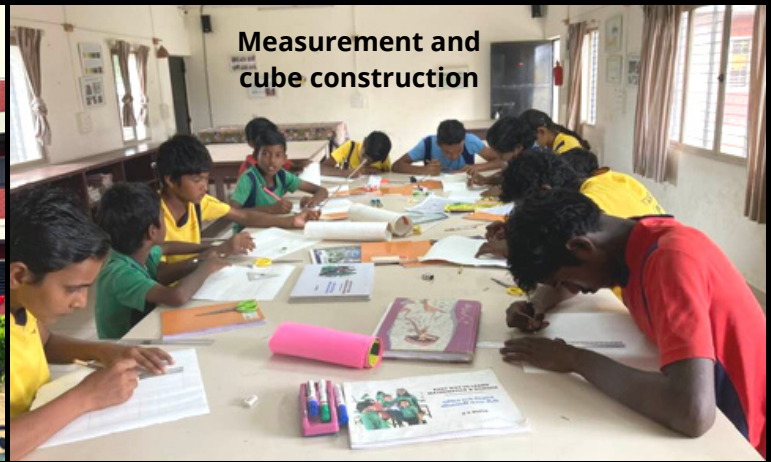
SKILL DEVELOPMENT CENTER

Our children from Level 4 to Class 8 attend the Skill Development Center classes hosted by Kajal Dutta Sir. They follow the handbook put together by Kajal Sir - "Easy way to learn Mathematics & Science". It's a hands-on approach to STEM education. 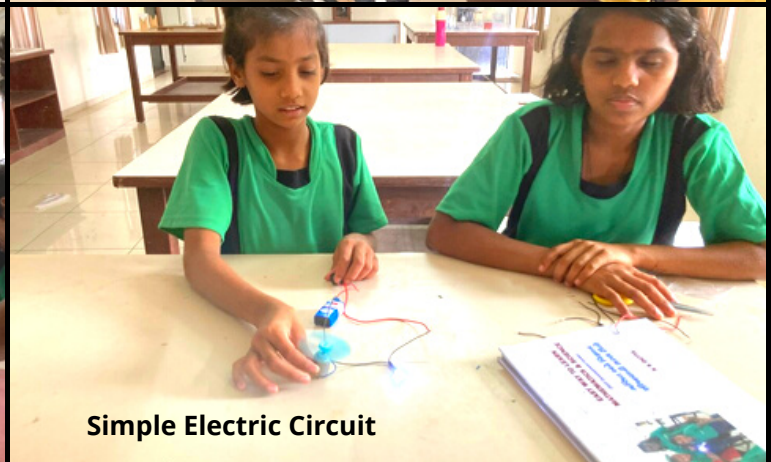

PROJECTS (PBL)

In the past year Pathshala is transitioned to a PBL approach to teaching and learning. We have 5 levels of learning and no grades till Grade 8. We do an in-depth study of the topic chosen. It covers - language development, general knowledge of the topic, history & geography related facts, socio-cultural aspects (if any). 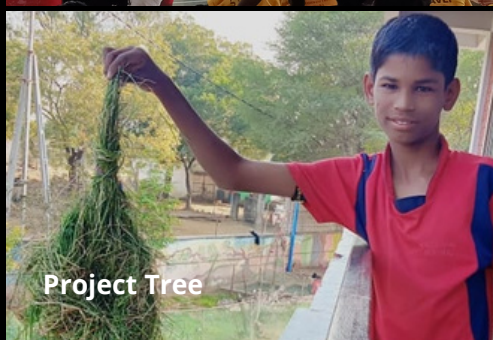

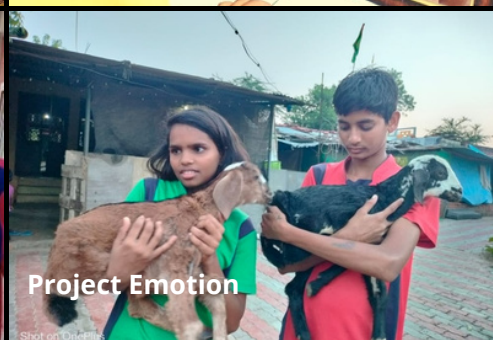

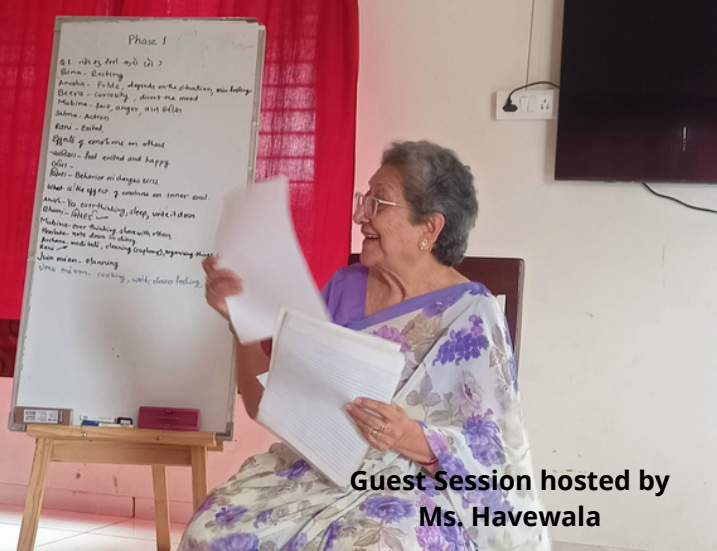

TEACHER TRAINING WORKSHOPS

They share their thoughts on everything from how to keep children motivated to what professionalism means to them. 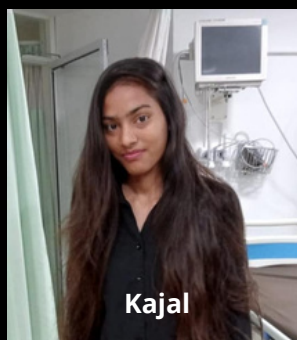

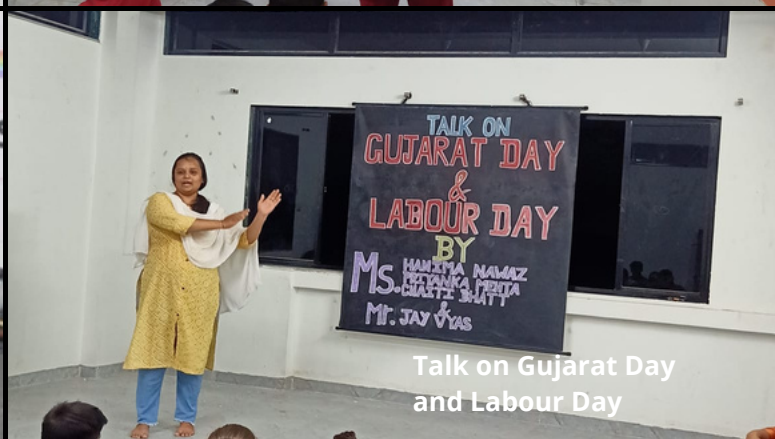

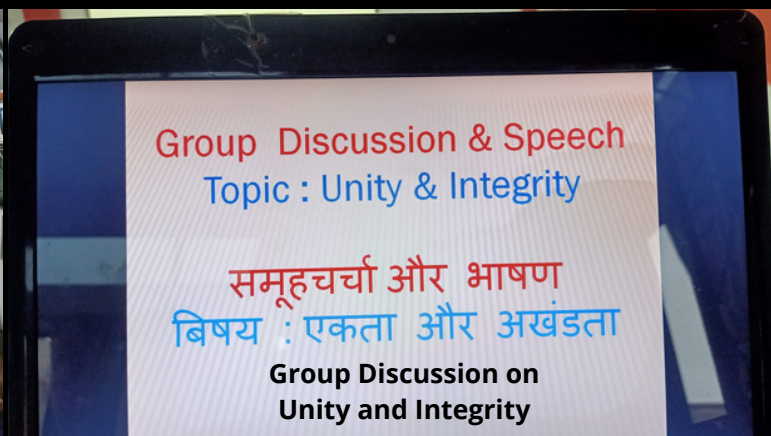
Pathbhavan uses the technique of gamification to encourage learning. The intention is for the teams to put in the extra effort in learning to win the competition.

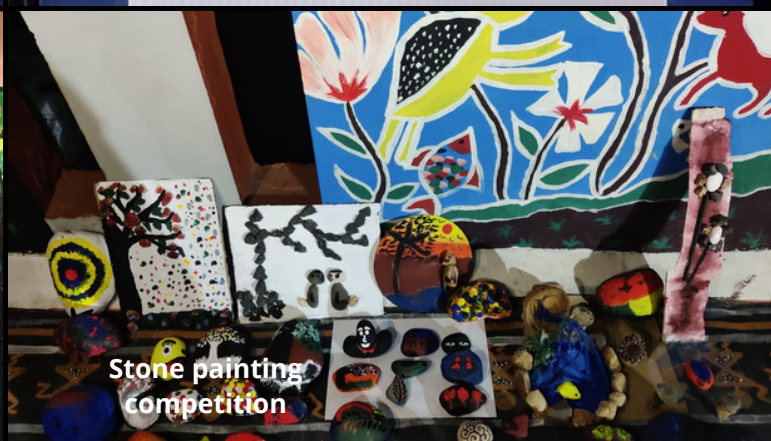

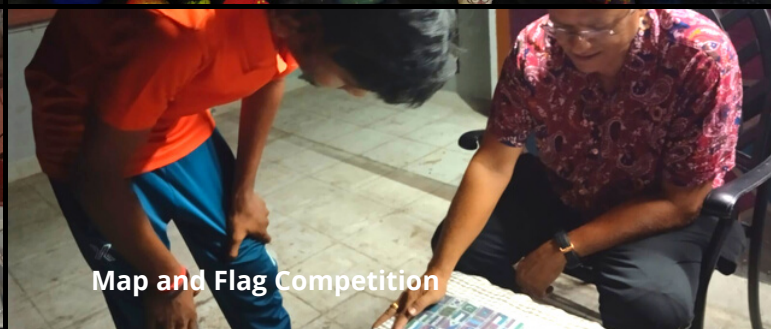

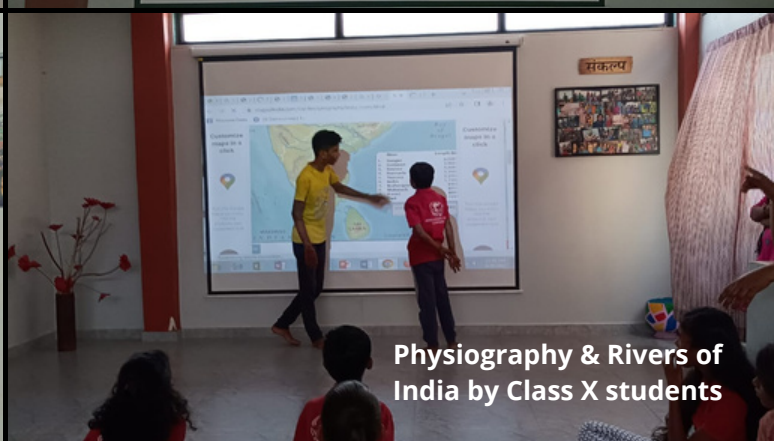

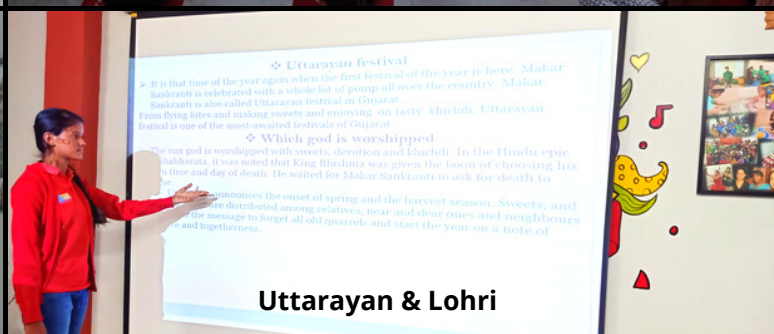
