

Udyam, our vocational training for our Pathshala and Pathbhavan children going strong at Pathbhavan With children getting involved in a Weekly basis.
















PEER LEARNING THROUGH TECHNOLOGY


OUTINGS

All the outings our children have taken. We always make sure that the trip is educational by discussing their pre and post trip notes and impression.



WORLD SCIENCE DAY

10th November was 'World Science Day'. We planned 5 days celebration to actively orient our children towards science.

Day 1:5 guest speakers interacted, demonstrated, related science with age old stories, explained facts audio-visually and made children understand that science is very much related to daily life.

Girish Sir (Scientist) told to be inquisitive (What, Why and how) to understand science. Mr. Dhruv Ramaiya (Entrepreneur) inspired for experiments to embibe science, Ms. Nandita Aich (teacher) directed children's attention towards stories to understand scientific laws, Mr. A. Datta (Former CEO, and mentor of Pathbhavan) did a few joyous experiments and our own student Arvind explained the cause of day & night & the concept of transparent - translucent objects.

Day 2: 26 students from Std. III to X participated in a science (pen & paper) quiz. A

Day 3: 17 students from Std. I to X explained human parts and organs through models and charts.

Day 4: 24 students from Std. III to X prepared digital Projects on various topics (Pollution, Balanced Food, Importance of Water, Process of Filtration, Changes around us, Photosynthesis, Respiration, Solar Energy, Digestive System, Sound, Metabolic System, Human Brain, Sunita William)

Day 5: 26 students from Std. | to X did experiments on 17 topics such as

Refraction of Light / Transparent, Solution, Solute, Solvent, Condition of Heat Transfer, Test of Acidic & Alkaline Solutions, Propagation of Sound Waves, Day & Night, Combustion & Flame etc


