UNNATI, MAKING FUTURE ENTREPRENEURS

UNNATI, MAKING FUTURE ENTREPRENEURS, IS a new initiative encouraging entrepreneurship in children! The initiative launched on March 20, 2024. Our children prepared their pitches and presented in front of a panel of investors. During their presentations, the panel got to taste their food products. They also had to justify their funding asks and took feedback regarding gaps in their planning. Currently the children are selling the following products - Jhalmudi, Kolkata Ghugni, Panipuri, Gola, Papdi nu lot, hand made natural soap, handmade weaved door mats in the villages near Lasundra. They also take bulk orders and the soaps are available in our Churni store. Most of them have started generating a profit. A part of the profit is re-invested back in the business. Two groups have donated part of their profit to the Trust for buying footballs and socks.



PATHSHALA - PROJECT BASED LEARNING

BOARD GAMES

One of the projects chosen for the first quarter of this year was board games. They enjoyed playing scrabbles, punishment, ludo, snakes and ladders, chess and many more board games. Children learnt about the history of board games, they explored online to find other versions of traditional board games and have interacted with experts. They worked on the design of their own version of the board games and created blue prints by discussing it with their teachers.

In the final phase of the project, children worked on creating their class models. Level 1 children created a life size model of the snakes and ladders game. Two groups made their own version of chess with their own kinds of pieces and rules. One was associated with characters of Ramayana. One of the groups created Ludo for the visually disabled. They took their board game to Sankul, a wonderful NGO that works with these children. Since executing the PBL approach to education, our children have become used to the applied form of education that includes - Ideation -> Research -> Planning -> Execution (Model making) -> Culmination/Completion.




They have started making profit.


TEAM COMPETITIONS & GUEST SPEAKERS
