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## OUR INITIATIVES

**Srotoshwini** is a Vadodara city based Trust, registered in 2010, primarily aimed at working towards the development of underprivileged children and women. The Trust is 12AA, 80G and FCRA compliant. There are 3 main initiatives that run under the Trust:

### Pathshala

- **Pathshala Informal School:** a school that has a hybrid learning program that marries the guidelines of Reggio Emilia Philosophy of child-centric education (Project Based Learning) with NIOS board learning expectations so the end result is a very skilled individual ready for joining the workforce.
- **Pathshala Hostel:** a residential facility for children where the focus is, all round development of the child including academics, sports, extra curricular activities, vocational training & career counseling. Pathshala classes now run on hostel campus.

**Pathbhavan** – A Learning and Development Center that runs in the after-school hours and focuses on nurturing the children of Sanjay Nagar Slum area (Vadodara) through academics and extra curricular activities for all round development.

**Churni:** a creative initiative that vocationally trains the mothers of our children to empower them by providing a steady income by selling the products they make. We have two centers, one in Gotri, Vadodara and another in Lasundra, Savli.



## MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT

2023-2024 has been a year of capitalizing on the foundation laid in the years of 2021 and 2022.

In Pathshala, we have fully transitioned to a Project Based Learning pedagogy till grade 8. We've completed 10+ projects in the past two years and both teachers and students are thriving in the inquiry based learning methodology.

Along with our teaching and learning methods, we have added a couple of new initiatives that helps our children take the philosophy of hands on learning further. We want to make sure that they transition to successful careers in the future.

Udukku, Udyam and Unnati are our 3 new initiatives that focus on the following - a traveling theater that encompasses all aspects of the arts, vocational training by industry experts and entrepreneurial exposure by running small scale businesses respectively. The greater vision is to marry our hybrid style of education with our hands-on initiatives seamlessly so that the end result is a confident child who is ready to transition to the workforce with training in soft and hard skills

Pathbhavan has always put their focus on academics and our children performed very well by getting 100% results in grade 10 and 12 both in 2023 and 2024. The focus on soft skills also continues with initiatives like the Infinity club, presentations on all important International days and very informative guest lectures and workshops.

Churni this year has returned to it's original location in Vadodara. Now it has two outlets in Vadodara - one in Gotri and the other in Sama. On an average there has been a conscious effort to host a few exhibitions every month. We've travelled to different cities outside of Vadodara like Pune, Bangalore, Delhi, Surat, Our social media presence has also become much stronger.

We are very thankful for the support we receive from all of you. We hope to continue to make our initiatives stronger for our children and ladies to truly thrive in.

# ACADEMICS

## Project Based Learning

Our teachers have developed their expertise in PBL under the able leadership of Ms. Paras Mahendru & Ms. Jyotsna Akre. This teaching methodology has been a big win for us in the last 3+ years. Our children are thinking more analytically and presenting their thoughts and conclusions in a well researched and professional manner. The exposure they are gaining from site visits and meeting industry experts is visible in their confidence. In the past year, we have completed 5 projects - Story, Monsoon, Textiles, Tribal Lives of the World, Board games & Rocks. Each of these projects had their culminations where the process and the end products were displayed and staged.

## Class X & XII & Diploma

While our plan is to continue with PBL at all the levels, the children will appear for Class X and XII exams held by the NIOS board. This year 7 of children are appearing for class XII, class X & Diploma exams.

## Job update:

Ajay, our eldest child who started a job at Singhal Sheets and Foil Pvt. Ltd finished his Diploma in Mechanical Engineering. Poonam and Sejal who have finished their XII have started an ITI course in Textile Fashion and also are working part-time to support themselves.

## Scholarships

# PATHSHALA INFORMAL SCHOOL


Pathshala School continues to flourish. All our levels have PBL classes where they learn through projects. In addition to core courses like Maths & Languages, we have introduced a subject called Our Country where the children are learning about the History of India through stories like the TV series Bharat Ek Khoj. Other aspects of our Country like people, their languages, partition and many more relevant issues are also discussed. Keeping hands on learning as our core focus, we have introduced Science by collaborating with organisations like Community Science Center who teach science through hands-on experiments. Our exams are also hybrid in nature with a mix of paper and pencil along with presentations through models, staged plays etc.



## PROJECTS (PBL)

In the past year Pathshala is transitioned to a PBL approach to teaching and learning. We have 5 levels of learning and no grades till Grade 8. We do an in-depth study of the topic chosen. It covers - language development, general knowledge of the topic, history & geography related facts, socio-cultural aspects (if any). All of these aspects are taught by encouraging students to be curious by asking questions, working on projects, model making and site visits etc. The projects completed in the past year - Story, Monsoon, Textiles, Tribal Lives of the World, Board games & Rocks



## UDUKKU: TRAVELING THEATER GROUP

We started 3 new initiatives this year that are a natural extension of our hands on approach to learning that we've been following for 3+ years through our PBL program.

Udukku is formed to make the journey of performing arts a tool for learning. Our children are involved in every aspect of the performance including venue, stage, costume, makeup etc. We have had two Udukku performances - one hosted as a fundraiser event by the Trust and the other was hosted by Rotary Club of Baroda Cosmopolitan. They invited our troupe to perform at their fundraising event.

Udukku's debut performance was Goopy Gawayia Bagha Bajaiya, a beautiful Hindi translation by Gulzaar Saab from Goopi Gayen Bagha Bayen, a Bengali play by Upendra Kishore Roy Chaudhury. Our performance was based on an animated film made by Ms Shilpa Ranade.

# UNNATI: CREATING ENTREPRENEURS OF THE FUTURE

It is one of our Enterpreneurial initiatives that was a suggestion of the National Education Policy (NEP 2020). Our senior students started by doing a pilot study by selling pani पूरी, Papdi nu loat, hand made mats etc. From planning to execution to calculating profit/ loss and replanning, everything was done by the students. After the Pilot phase, there was a Shark tank like investment round organised in our Lasundra campus in March, 2024 where different members from the industry participated and invested in our children's initiatives. Currently the children are selling the following products - Pani puri, Papdi nu lot, Jhal muri, Ghugni, Gola, Hand made natural soap & hand weaved door mats. Before the summer break in 2024, the children started generating a profit and all teams donated Rs.1000 to the Trust for athletic socks and footballs.



With our transition to Project Based Learning, it is very important that we are continuously learning as teachers through workshops, guest lectures and in-depth training. Since the teaching methodology is less conventional, it is not easy to implement everything effectively from Day 1. It requires our teachers to think on their feet, be creative, continuously plan and execute so that the children receive the maximum benefit.

Every academic year is started with an orientation training where we review the vision & mission of the Trust so that everyone has a clear understanding of the big picture. We then dig deeper into teaching methodology and address specific topics. All through the year we invite guest speakers to our campus with many years of teaching experience or industry experience. They share their thoughts on everything from how to keep children motivated to what professionalism means to them. All of these sessions have not only been very informational but great source of motivation for our team.




